

Siubhal dhan Cholaiste / Travel to the College

Ma tha sibh a' siubhal à tìr-mòr na Roinn Eòrpa, tha puirt-adhair ann an Dùn Èideann, Glaschu (Eadar-nàiseanta), Glaschu (Prestabhaig) agus Inbhir Nis. 'S e Inbhir Nis as fhaisge air Sabhal Mòr Ostaig (mu 100 mìle/160km) ach uaireannan chan e as goireasaiche airson siubhail air adhart don Cholaiste a rèir cuin a ruigeas sibh.

If you are travelling from Continental Europe you may fly to Glasgow International, Glasgow Prestwick, Edinburgh or Inverness airports, which are well served by several European airlines. Inverness is closest to the college (approximately 100 miles or 160km) though not necessarily the most convenient for onward travel, depending on arrival time.

Mas ann à Canada, Na Stàitean Aonaichte no àiteigin eile san t-saoghal a tha sibh an dùil siubhal, 's e Air Canada, Air Transat, Icelandair, WestJet, American, Delta, United, agus Emirates feadhainn de na companaidhean adhair a bhios a' siubhal gu Glaschu (Eadar-nàiseanta) no Dùn Èideann, ach is ann aig amannan sònraichte den bhliadhna a bhitheas iad a' siubhal. Faodaidh sibh siubhal gu Lunnainn agus an uair sin ceangal fhaighinn gu Glaschu (Eadar-nàiseanta), Inbhir Nis no Dùn Èideann. Tha cothrom ann cuideachd a dhol gu Amsterdam Schipol anns an Òlaind, agus a dhol air adhart às a sin. 'S e port adhair fada nas goireasaiche na Lunnainn (Heathrow) a th' ann agus tha cothrom ann plèan fhaighinn gu tric don dà chuid Glaschu (Eadar-nàiseanta), Dùn Èideann agus, gu fo-mhinig, Inbhir Nis. An coimeas ri Canada agus Na Stàitean Aonaichte far a bheil feum aig daoine air a dhol tro sgrùdadh chrìochan agus cusbainn nuair a thòisichear air siubhal, cha bhi agaibh ach ri dhol tro sgrùdadh chrìochan aig an toiseach agus cusbainn aig deireadh an t-siubhail ma tha sibh a' siubhal don Rìoghachd Aonaichte bho thìr-mòr na Roinn Eòrpa leis an aon chompanaidh adhair. Mar sin, chan eil feum agaibh air na bagaichean agaibh a thogail is an gluasad gu plèan eile ann an Lunnainn no Amsterdam. Dèanaibh cinnteach mu dheidhinn seo le bhith a' bruidhinn ris a' chompanaidh siubhail ro làimh.

If you are travelling from Canada or USA, or elsewhere in the world, Air Canada, Air Transat, Icelandair, WestJet, American, Delta, United, and Emirates are some of the airlines which operate directly into Glasgow International or Edinburgh, though some services are seasonal. You may also fly into London and make a domestic connection from there to Glasgow International, Inverness or Edinburgh, but you may also wish to consider flying into Amsterdam Schipol in the Netherlands and connecting there – it's a far easier airport to negotiate than London Heathrow and there are frequent connections to Glasgow International and Edinburgh, with a less frequent service to Inverness. Unlike Canada and USA where you may go through both Border Control and Customs at your port of entry, when travelling to the UK and Europe provided you make your connection with the same airline at the same airport your bags will normally be checked through to your final destination, and whilst you will go through Border Control at your port of entry you will not usually encounter Customs until your final destination airport. As such there is no need to collect your bags in London Heathrow or Amsterdam, though you should check this with your airline.

Draibheadh:-

'S ann air an taobh CHLÌ den rathad a bhios carbadan a' siubhal ann an Alba, coltach ris a' chòrr den Rìoghachd Aonaichte agus Èirinn. Tha astar siubhail ceadaichte gan toirt seachad mar **mhilltean** san uair, chan ann mar cilemeatair san uair mar a tha an Èirinn agus a chuid eile den Roinn Eòrpa. 'S e 60 mìle san uair (96 cm san uair) an t-astar siubhail ceadaichte air rathaidean dùthchail ann an Alba (ach nuair a tha astar eile ga thaisbeanadh). Tha sinn an dòchas gun còrd an turas ribh ach, cuideachd, gum bi sibh mothachail ma tha daoine air ur cùlaibh air an rathad gun leig sibh seachad iad – gu h-àraid ma tha sreath de chàraichean ann. 'S dòcha gu bheil cabhag air daoine eile agus iad eòlach air na rathaidean cuideachd. Tachraidh tubaistean an dèidh do dhaoine bhith cabhagach an dèidh bhith air an cumail air ais agus a' call foighidinn. Cuimhnichibh gu bheil aig càr ri cumail ris an taobh chlà ach a-mhàin nuair a tha sibh gu bhith dol seachad air car eile. Chan eil e ceadaichte a dhol seachad air carbad air an taobh chlà. Mar as àbhaist, is e 70 an t-astar as luaithe a tha ceadaichte air rathaidean mòra ach, aig amannan bidh seo air a lughdachadh gu 50 no nas lugha buileach ann an suidheachaidhean sònraichte. m.e. ann am baile.

Driving:-

*Traffic in Scotland and the rest of the UK and Ireland drives on the LEFT side of the road. Fuel prices displayed at filling-stations are quoted per Litre. One Imperial Gallon is equal to 4.55 Litres. One US Gallon is equal to 3.79 Litres. Speed limits throughout the UK are given in Statute Miles per Hour, NOT Kilometres per Hour as they are in Ireland and the rest of Europe. Unless otherwise indicated the speed limit on rural roads in Scotland is **60mph**, which is approximately **96km/h**. We want you to enjoy your visit but please be courteous to other road users and allow faster traffic behind you to pass by pulling over occasionally, especially if there is a queue behind you – not everyone is on holiday with time to admire the scenery, and frustration leads to accidents. This is especially important on single-track roads but is also relevant on winding main roads where opportunities for safe overtaking are limited. Unless otherwise indicated the speed limit on motorways and dual-carriageways is **70mph (Approx 112km/h)**, often reduced to 50mph (80km/h) or less in urban areas. Speed-enforcement cameras are routinely used throughout the UK, some of which are linked together to measure average speed over long distances rather than instantaneous speed at the point of passing the camera. On multi-lane roads and motorways keep to the left-most lane where possible. It is an offence to overtake a vehicle on its left side so do not use the right-most lane unless overtaking as this blocks the flow of traffic; lane discipline is more strictly enforced in UK than in most countries and Police will issue a fine should they observe violations.*

Tha mòran rathaidean ann an Alba a tha singilte le àite far an tèid carbadan seachad. Chan eil na rathaidean seo leathann gu leòr airson dà charbad. Air na rathaidean cumhang, singilte, tha e na chleachdadh gun stad a' chiad chàr a ruigeas àite dol seachad, às bith dè an taobh air a bheil an t-àite. Ma tha e air ur làimh clì, rachaibh a-steach. Ma tha e air ur làimh dheas, stadaibh ma choinneamh. Ma thèid sibh seachad air àite airson a dhol seachad air car, agus gu bheil sibh nas fhaisge air carbad a tha tighinn gad ionnsaigh, feumaidh sibh a dhol air ais don àite airson a dhol seachad. Cha bu chòir gum biodh daoine parcadh anns na h-àiteachean airson dol seachad a chionn 's gun adhbharaich sin trioblaidean, gun dèan sin siubhal nas slaodaiche, agus dh'fhaodadh an carbad agaibh a bhith air a thoirt air falbh oirbh. Nuair a thachras sibh ri carbad eile aig àite dol seachad, tha e na chleachdadh modhail smèideadh ris an draibhear eile. Tha àite airson dol seachad aithnichte le post le cumadh daoimean agus "passing-place" sgrìobhte air. Tha àiteachean-parcaidh rin aithneachadh le "P" geal air dath gorm.

Many roads in rural Scotland are narrow "single track roads with passing-places", which are not wide enough for two vehicles to pass. When using single track roads it is customary when meeting oncoming traffic that the vehicle which reaches the passing-place first stops, regardless of which side of the road the passing-place is on. If the passing-place is on your left, drive into it. If the passing-place is on your right, stop opposite it – do not drive into it. Should you go past a passing-place and you are closer to one than oncoming traffic you will be expected to reverse back to the passing-place. Please do not use passing-places as car parks as this impedes the flow of traffic and your vehicle may be towed away. When passing another vehicle at a passing-place it is customary to acknowledge the other vehicle – not to do so is considered rude. Passing-places are indicated by a white diamond or square with the words "passing-place". Parking lay-bys are indicated by a white "P" on a blue background.



Ma gheibh sibh càr air màl ann an **Glaschu**, faodaidh sibh dràibheadh gu **Malaig** (mu 150 mìle) ach bheir e mu 4 uairean a thìde agus ùine a bharrachd ma bhios sibh a' stad. Gheibh sibh am bàt-aiseig à Malaig gu **Armadal** ma bhios an aimsir freagarrach. Bidh feum agaibh air àite a chur air dòigh air a' bhàta agus bheir e mu 30 mionaid air a dhol tarsaing. Feumaidh sibh a bhith ann am Malaig 30 mionaid ron àm seòlaidh. Bidh cothrom agaibh cuideachd a dhol tarsaing na drochaid aig **Caol Loch Aillse**. Bheir e mu 4.5 uair sa chàr o Ghlaschu (mu 200 mìle), agus 2.5 uair ma thig sibh bhon phort-adhair faisg air Inbhir Nis. Bidh sibh nas luaithe na seo air latha nuair a bhios an rathad sàmhach. Tha mu 100 mìle ann don drochaid aig Caol Loch Aillse. Ma thig sibh à **Dùn Èideann**, thigibh taobh **Dhail-Chuinnidh** gu **Drochaid an Aonachain** agus air adhart gu **Malaig**. Bheir sin mu 4.5 uair a thìde le ùine airson stad is fois a ghabhail. Faodaidh sibh cuideachd dèanamh air **Caol Loch Aillse** bhon taobh sin. Bheir e mun aon ùine. Bhiodh sibh a' seachnadh a' bhàt-aiseig an uair sin, dòigh na bu chinntiche, 's dòcha, air latha nach eil an aimsir cho math.

*If you hire a car in **Glasgow**, drive to **Malaig** (approx. 150 miles from Glasgow, but allow 4 hours to Malaig + rest stops as the roads are narrow and winding) and take the ferry to Armadale (again subject to weather). Advance reservation for vehicles is compulsory for this route and you must check in 30 mins before departure. The crossing takes 30 to 40 mins depending on the vessel. Alternatively go via Kyle of Lochalsh to avoid the ferry - approx. 200 miles from Glasgow – allow 4.5 hours + rest stops.*

OR

*If you hire a car in **Inverness**, drive via **Kyle of Lochalsh** and come over the bridge, approx. 100 miles from Inverness – allow 2.5 hours.*

OR

*If you hire a car in **Edinburgh**, drive via **Dalwhinnie & Spean Bridge** to **Malaig** - allow 4.5 hours in total + rest stops. Alternatively go via **Inverness** and **Kyle of Lochalsh** to avoid the ferry – 5.5 hours + rest stops.*

Càr air màl san Eilean

Nuair a ruigeas sibh port-adhair air tìr mòr, 's dòcha gum faigh sibh càr an sin, gu h-àraid ma tha sibh airson an càr a chumail fhad 's a tha feum agaibh air. Ach tha fiosrachadh ceangailte gu h-òosal mu àiteachan a tha cur chàraichean air màl agus a dh'fhàgas càr dhuibh aig an stèisean no aig port aiseig. Faodaidh sin a bhith feumail airson neach san bith nach eil feumach air càr ach airson nan làithean a tha iad air an eilean. Chan eil sinn a' moladh tè seach tè de na companaidhean seo ach tha sinn an dòchas gum bi seo feumail dhuibh.

Car Hire on the Island

Those arriving at a major airport may wish to hire a car there, especially if you intend keeping the vehicle for the whole duration of your stay. However, information is provided below for local car-hire companies, many of whom will deliver a vehicle for collection at Kyle of Lochalsh railway station or one of the ferry terminals, which might be a useful alternative for those who only need a car for a few days whilst on the island. We do not recommend any particular supplier but hope the list is of use to you.



Còmhdhail Phoblach

Port-adhair Inbhir Nis:- Bus bhon phort-adhair gu Inbhir Nis, an uair sin:-

1. Trèana gu Caol Loch Aillse (mu 80 mìle, 2 uair a thìde), an uair sin tacsì don Cholaiste (mu 20 mìle).
NO
2. Bus bho Inbhir Nis don Ath Leathann (mu 90 mìle), an uair sin bus/tacsì don Cholaiste (15 mìle). Chan eil busaichean cho cunbhalach gu Slèite. A rèir cuin a thig sibh 's dòcha gum bi daoine eile air tighinn air a' bhus a tha airson a dhol don Cholaiste agus leis am b' urrainn dhuibh tacsì fhaighinn.

Port-adhair Ghlaschu (mu 10 mìle bho mheadhan Baile Ghlaschu:-

Bus dìreach bhon phort-adhair gu Stèisean Sràid na Bànrigh (**Chan e Stèisean Central**). An uair sin leanaibh am fiosrachadh gu h-ìosal bho “Baile Ghlaschu”. NO bus dìreach 915 Citylink bhon phort-adhair don Eilean Sgitheanach.

Port-adhair Phreastabhaig (mu 30 mìle bho Ghlaschu) :-

Tha Stèisean aig a' phort-adhair far am faighear trèana Stèisean Central ann an Glaschu (mu 45 mionaidean). Tha sgrìob ghoirid ri choisèachd gu Stèisean Sràid na Bànrigh no stèisean nam busaichean air Sràid Bhochanan, às bith dè as fhreagarraiche.

Tha bus ann cuideachd (shuttle bus). Gheibh sibh ceangal mar a tha freagarrach dhuibh bhon fiosrachadh fo “Baile Ghlaschu” gu h-ìosal.

Baile Ghlaschu

Tha cothrom agaibh na leanas a thaghadh:-

1. Trèana bho Stèisean na Bànrigh (chan e CENTRAL), gu Malaig (mu 150 mìle, agus 5.5 uair a thìde). *Is àbhaist don trèana seo bhith a' dealachadh aig a' Chrìon-làraich, agus leth phàirt den trèana a' dol don Òban agus an leth eile a' dol taobh a' Ghearasdain agus taobh Mhalaig. **Mar sin, dèanaibh cinnteach gun tèid sibh dhan àite-suidhe cheart air an trèana.*** Tha e nas fheàrr àite a ghleidheadh airson an turais eadar Gearasdan Lochabar agus Malaig bhon a tha an cèarn seo den sgìre gu math ainmeil is e a' nochdadh ann am film “Harry Potter”. Thèid sibh tarsaing na drochaid ainmeil ann an Gleann Fhionghain. Bho Mhalaig gabhaibh am bàta gu Armadal (seòladh mu 30-45 mionaid a rèir dè am bàta bhios ann). Feumaidh sibh a bhith ann 15 mionaidean ro làimh. Tha a' Cholaiste (SMO) mu 2 mhìle bhon chidhe ann an Armadal.

NO

2. Faighibh bus bho Stèisean Bus Sràid Bhochanan don Àth Leathann (mu 190 mìle, 7 uairean a thìde. 'S ann air adhart gu Port Rìgh agus Ùige a bhios na busaichean a' dol aig a' cheann thall ach stadaidh iad san Àth Leathann). Bhon Àth Leathann faighibh bus/tacsì don Cholaiste (SMO). Chan eil busaichean ann gu cunbhalach ach 's dòcha gum bi daoine eile ann a tha dol don Cholaiste agus a bhiodh deònach tacsì a chur air dòigh còmhla ribh.

Dùn Èideann

Faodaidh sibh taghadh a dhèanamh eadar:-

1. Bus/trèana gu baile Dhùn Èideann, an uair sin trèana bho Stèisean Haymarket no Waverley gu Caol Loch Aillse (mu 230 mìle) le atharrachadh ann an Inbhir Nis. Tha cothrom ann cuideachd bus fhaighinn bho Inbhir Nis don Àth Leathann agus an uair sin bus/tacsì fad mu 20 mìle don Cholaiste.

NO

2. Bus bhon phort-adhair ann an Dùn Èideann don Stèisean Bhusaichean (Sràid Bhochanan) an Glaschu (mu 40 mìle agus suas ri 1.5 uair a thìde a rèir dè cho trang 's a tha an rathad). An uair sin, leanaibh am fiosrachadh gu h-àrd airson siubhail bho bhaile Ghlaschu.

Public Transport

Inverness Airport:- Take a bus from the airport to Inverness, then:-

Either:-

1. Train to **Kyle of Lochalsh** (approx. 80 miles, 2hrs 40m) and then a taxi to the college (20 miles approximately).

OR

2. Take a bus from Inverness to **Broadford** (approx. 90 miles). From Broadford a bus or taxi to the college, (15 miles) though buses are infrequent. Depending on your time of arrival you may find there are other people travelling to the college with whom you may be able to share a taxi.

Glasgow International Airport (10 miles from the city):-

Either

1. Take the express bus from the airport to **Glasgow Queen Street Railway Station** (NOT Central Station), or **Glasgow Buchanan St Bus Station** as appropriate (15-30 mins depending on traffic), then follow directions from Glasgow City below.

OR

2. Take Scottish Citylink bus service 915 from the airport direct to Broadford, Isle of Skye (approx. 180 miles, 7 hours). From Broadford take a bus or taxi to the college (15 miles), though buses are infrequent. Depending on your time of arrival you may find there are other people travelling with you to the college with whom you may be able to share a taxi.

Glasgow Prestwick Airport (30 miles from the city):-

The airport has its own railway station with a regular service to **Glasgow Central** station (approx. 45 mins). It's a short walk from there to **Glasgow Queen St Station** or **Buchanan St Bus station** as appropriate (or you can take the shuttle bus) where you can make connections from "Glasgow City" explained below.

Glasgow City:-

Either

1. Take a train from **Glasgow Queen Street** station (NOT Central) to **Malaig** (approx. 150 miles, 5.5 hours). This train is often split at Crianlarich with one half going to Oban and the other going to Fort William & Malaig, **so ensure you sit in the correct carriage for your destination**. Reservation may be essential between Fort William and Malaig – this route is famous for its scenic views, and for those interested in "Harry Potter", you'll cross over the famous viaduct at Glenfinnan and go past Hogwarts Castle (though the castle itself is invisible to Muggles). Take the ferry from Malaig to **Armadale** (approx. 30 – 40 mins crossing – foot passengers must check in 15 mins in advance of departure). The college is about 2 miles from the ferry terminal. There is a bus service from the ferry terminal which passes the college, or you may find there are others travelling to the college with whom you could share a taxi.

OR

2. Take a bus from **Glasgow Buchanan St** bus station to **Broadford** (approx. 190 miles, 7 hours - buses to Portree and Uig (Skye) usually stop in Broadford). From Broadford take a bus or taxi to the college (15 miles), though buses are infrequent. Again, depending on your time of arrival you may find there are other people travelling with you to the college with whom you may be able to share a taxi.

Edinburgh Airport:-

Either

1. Take a bus or tram to Edinburgh city and then train from either **Haymarket** or **Waverley** stations to **Kyle of Lochalsh** (approx. 230 miles with a change at Inverness) or bus to **Broadford** (240 miles with a change at Inverness), and then a taxi to the college (approx. 20 miles).

OR

2. Take the express bus from Edinburgh Airport to **Glasgow Buchanan St Bus Station** (approx. 40 miles, up to 1.5 hours depending on traffic) and follow the connection information from **Glasgow City**.

Airgead

'S e an not (£) a tha ga chleachdadh ann an Alba agus san Rìoghachd Aònaichte gu lèir. Chan eil airgead eile (an Euro nam measg) gan cleachdadh gu h-àbhaisteach nan dòighean pàighidh.

Tha cead aig trì bancaichean Albannach an cuid airgid len ainm air a sgoileadh. Banca na h-Alba, Banca Rìoghail na h-Alba, Banca Dàil Chluaidh agus cuideachd Banca Shasainn air an cleachdadh ann an Alba. Tha iad sin uile ceadichte anns an Rìoghachd Aonaichte ged a dhiùltas feadhainn de ghnìomhachasan a h-uile not ach notaichean Banca Shasainn. Gabhaidh banca a h-uile seòrsa dhiubh agus bheir iad airgead eile seachad an àite notaichean sam bith. Gheibhear fios a bharrachd an seo:-

Tha Visa agus Mastercard mar chairtean Cr agus Dr gan cleachdadh mar as àbhaist ann an dùthaich sam bith. Chan eil cairtean American Express gan gabhail cho tric ann an cuid de shuidheachaidhean a bharrachd air gnìomhachasan mòra a leithid thaighean-òsta agus taighean-bìdh. Uaireannan bidh cosgais a bharrachd ann airson chairtean creideis ach chan eil sin cho cumanta le cairtean dr.

Gu h-àbhaisteach tha cosgaisean VAT an lùib na prìs a chithear air bathar agus 's e sin an t-suim a phàighear. Tha seo eadar-dhealaichte ris an dòigh anns am bith cosgaisean cìs (VAT) gan cur ri prìs ann an dùthchannan leithid Canada 's na Stàitean Aonaichte. Chan eil VAT air dòighean-siubhail poblach ach air tacsì a mhàin. Ach tha VAT air biadh agus deoch ma tha sibh ga thoirt leibh às an àite ullachaidh mar bhùth/àite-bìdh. Mas ann às àite nach eil san Roinn Eòrpa a tha sibh, 's dòcha gum bi cothrom ann VAT fhaighinn air ais ma chumas sibh cuidhteasan a sheallas VAT. Chan eil bileagan cairt-creideis math gu leòr airson seo. Feumaidh gach àite tha air a chlàradh airson VAT cuidhteas a sheallas suim VAT a thoirt seachad ma thèid iarraidh - gheibhear seo co-dhiù, mar as àbhaist.

Currency

The unit of currency in Scotland and the rest of the United Kingdom is the Pound Sterling (GBP, £1 = 100 pence). Other currencies (including Euros) are not generally accepted.

Three Scottish banks are authorised to issue Sterling currency notes; the Bank of Scotland, the Royal Bank of Scotland, and the Clydesdale Bank, and notes from all three of these banks circulate widely in Scotland. Bank of England notes are also used. All of these are legal currency throughout the United Kingdom although some businesses in England & Wales have been known to refuse any note not issued by the Bank of England. All banks throughout the UK will accept any genuine Sterling note from any authorised issuer and exchange as required. Foreign Exchange bureaux outside of the UK may be less familiar with Scottish notes and may offer less favourable exchange rates. Further information, including images of notes for familiarisation, may be obtained from the Committee of Scottish Bankers website:- <http://www.scotbanks.org.uk/>.

Visa and Mastercard credit and debit cards are almost universally accepted. American Express is less widely accepted outside of large chain hotels and restaurants. Some businesses require a minimum spend to pay by card (usually £10).

All prices displayed on goods in shops already include VAT (sales tax) where appropriate so there is no need to add this separately as is customary in some countries such as Canada and USA. Public Transport does not normally attract VAT (though VAT is payable on taxi fares). VAT is, however, payable on hot take-away food and drinks and you may find two prices displayed depending on whether you purchase your food/drink "to go" or consume it on the premises. If you live outside of the European Union you may be able to recover the VAT on purchased goods when you take them out of the UK if you retain VAT receipts; credit card receipt vouchers are not acceptable for this purpose. All VAT-registered businesses must issue a VAT receipt on request, and most do so automatically.
